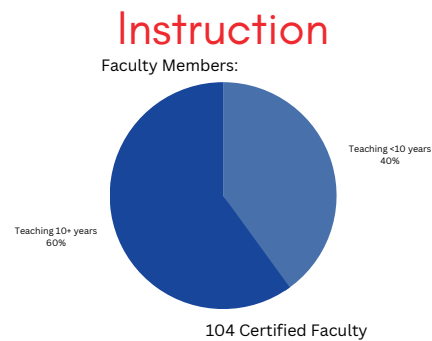
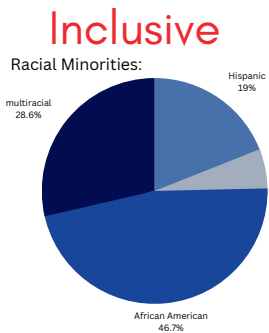
LEGACY MATTERS

The mission of Kokomo High School is to enable our students to become lifelong learners as the result of a safe and positive learning environment, where legacy matters. Each student is challenged in a culture of excellence and achievement, which enables students to develop thinking and learning skills to achieve personal growth and maximum potential.

CULTURALLY DIVERSE

Kokomo High School takes pride in its culturally-rich student population of close to 1,500 students, 35% of which are in racial minority groups, in grades 9-12. Approximately 55% of the students participate in the free/reduced lunch program. Each academic year, around 50 students from various corners of the globe choose to study at Kokomo High School. Since 2012, KHS has welcomed over 700 international students from over 50 countries.

KHS students learn from each other while experiencing a rigorous and engaging curriculum through a variety of academic programs, as well as co-curricular and extra-curricular activities offered at Kokomo High School.



CURRICULUM

The school year consists of 180 days divided into two semesters. The school day has 7 periods each lasting 50 minutes. KHS students have an incredible number of challenging academic programs from which to choose.

Kokomo High School is authorized as a World School in the International Baccalaureate (IB) Middle Years Program (MYP), IB Diploma Program (DP), and IB Career-Related Program (CP).

Career and Technical Education (CTE) courses are offered at the Kokomo Area Career Center, which is conveniently located within the campus of Kokomo High School.

Kokomo High School's 24 Advanced Placement (AP) courses rival any high school in Indiana.

AP courses prepare students for AP exams, which can earn them college credit and/or exempt them from freshman-level college courses. AP courses are weighted, adding 1.0 to the grade earned on a 4.0 GPA scale. Last year, Kokomo High School administered 395 AP tests. Available courses at KHS are listed above. Courses with (*) were not offered in 2022-2023 or 2023-2024 due to enrollment or staffing issues.

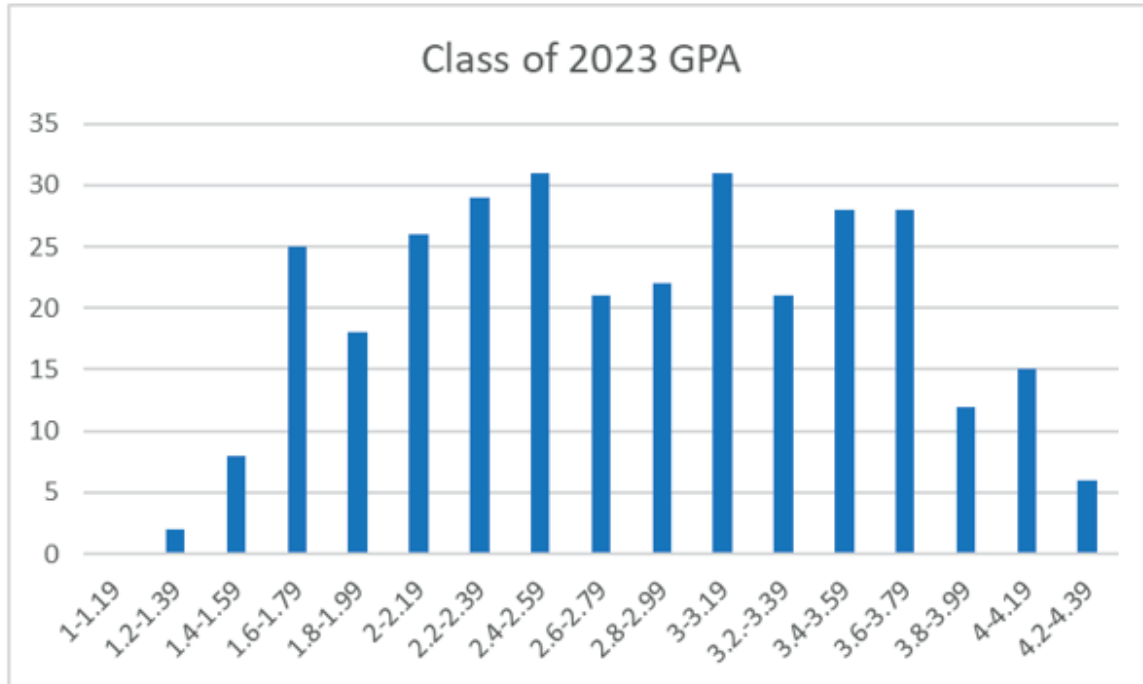
GRADING SCALE & CLASS RANK

Kokomo High School determines GPA by dividing total points by the total number of credits attempted. Grades are weighted for AP and IB DP courses. During the 2022-2023 school year, KHS commenced weighting dual credit classes in core areas. Weighted grades add an additional 1.0 grade point to a 4-point scale. **Kokomo High School does not rank students.**

DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS

KHS students are able to earn a **General Diploma** or:

- **Core 40 diploma:** Earn 40 total credits including: 8 in Language Arts, 6 in Mathematics (including Algebra I, Algebra II, and Geometry), 6 in Science, 6 in Social Studies, 2 in Physical Education, and 1 in Health. Additionally, the state requires graduates earn a graduation pathway.
- **Core 40 with Academic Honors diploma:** Fulfill all of the Core 40 requirements, take additional college preparatory coursework (advanced math, foreign language, and fine arts) for a total of 47 credits, and have a minimum GPA of 3.0. Students must also demonstrate college readiness through AP, IB, and/or dual credit courses and exams.
- **Core 40 with Technical Honors diploma:** Fulfill all of the Core 40 requirements, earn 47 total credits including 6 credits in a career-technical program, and have a minimum GPA of 3.0. Students must also demonstrate college and career readiness through dual credits, assessments, certifications, and coursework.
- **International Baccalaureate diploma:** Meet the DP requirements set forth by IB.

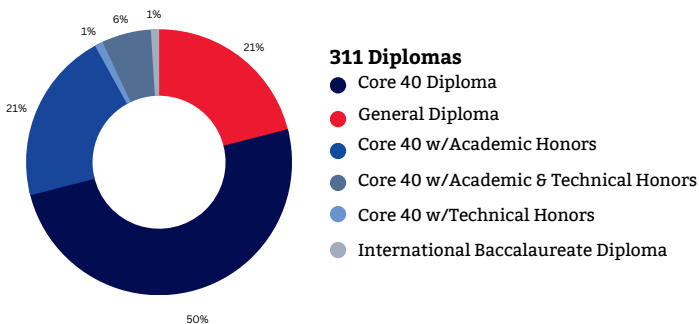

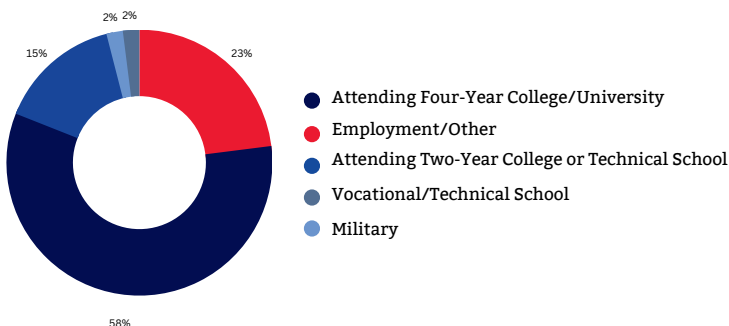
